**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for the purpose of Pumping, Cleaning & Disposal of Solids and Liquids from the Oil Water Separator located at 6255 North Jog Road, West Palm Beach, FL in conjunction with the Authority's needs on an as needed basis. (No guarantee of amount of work).

**AWARD – PRIMARY AND SECONDARY (Services)**

Contract will be awarded to the lowest and best quote from a responsive, responsible bidder, subject to the terms and conditions herein.

The Authority reserves the right to make a primary and secondary award. The lowest bidder meeting specifications, terms and conditions shall be the primary awardee. The next lowest bidder meeting specifications, terms and conditions shall be secondary awardees. If the primary contractor cannot respond to a service request within the time stipulated in their quote response,

the secondary vendor will be contacted to perform the required work. More than two (2) occurrences of failure to respond in a timely manner shall be deemed as a default of contract. (See Special Terms and Conditions, "Right to Terminate").

The Authority reserves the unqualified right, in the Authority's sole and absolute discretion, to reject any and all quotes, to waive any irregularities, or to accept the quote which, in the Authority's judgment, will under all circumstances, best serve the public's interest.

### **OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL YEARS (With Price Adjustment)**

The initial contract prices resultant from this solicitation shall prevail for a one (1) year period from the contract's initial effective date. Prior to, or upon completion, of that initial term, the Authority shall have the option to renew this contract for an additional two (2) year period on a year to year basis. Prior to completion of each exercised contract term, the Authority may consider an adjustment to price based on changes in the following pricing index: All Urban consumers, Miami-Fort Lauderdale, Florida, other Goods and Services.

It is the vendor's responsibility to request any pricing adjustment under this provision. For any adjustment to commence on the first day of any exercised option period, the vendor's request for adjustment should be submitted thirty (30) days prior to expiration of the then current contract term. The vendor adjustment request should not be in excess of the relevant pricing index change. If no adjustment request is received from the vendor, the Authority will assume that the vendor has agreed that the optional term may be exercised without pricing adjustment.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any price adjustments submitted by the vendor and/or to not exercise any otherwise available option period based on such price adjustments. Continuation of the contract beyond the initial period, and any option subsequently exercised, is an Authority prerogative, and not a right of the vendor. This prerogative will be exercised only when such continuation is clearly in the best interest of the Authority.

### **QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS**

This quote shall be awarded only to a responsible bidder, qualified to provide the work specified. **The bidder shall submit the following information with his quote:**

- A. Experience record showing the bidder's training and experience in similar work.
- B. List and brief description of similar work satisfactorily completed with location, dates of contracts, names, addresses and phone numbers of owners.
- C. List of equipment and facilities available to do the work.
- D. Compliance with OSHA regulations for Permit-required Confined Spaces – 1910.146

Failure to submit the above requested information with Quote or within three (3) days of request, may be cause for rejection of your quote. Information previously submitted to the Authority in response to another Request for Quote shall not satisfy this requirement. The term "*experience*", as used in this requirement, shall mean the experience gained as and possessed by the business entity proper (single proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or joint venture) responding to this quotation. It shall not mean the experience of individual employee(s).

## **LICENSES AND PERMITS**

It shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to obtain, at no additional cost to the Authority, any and all licenses and permits required to complete this contractual service. A copy of these licenses and permits shall be submitted to the Authority prior to commencement of work, if applicable.

## **METHOD OF ORDERING**

Service shall be ordered via individual purchase orders on an "as needed" basis or Blanket orders for services at specified intervals for the term of the contract. **Invoices must be submitted against each individual purchase order or blanket purchase order release.**

Service call shall be made within time established in vendor's quote response.

## **QUANTITY AND DATES, ESTIMATED**

The quantities and dates shown are estimates. The Authority reserves the right to increase or decrease the total quantities and dates as necessary to meet actual requirements.

## **RIGHT TO TERMINATE**

In the event that any of the provisions of the contract are violated by the successful bidder, the Authority shall serve written notice upon such bidder of its intention to terminate the contract. Such notice is to state the reason(s) for such intention to terminate the contract. The liability of the bidder for any and all such violation(s) shall not be affected by any such termination.

## **OSHA REQUIREMENTS**

Contractor shall at all times comply with OSHA Regulations, Permit-required Confined Spaces - 1910.146.

## **CODES AND REGULATIONS**

The vendor must strictly comply with all Federal, State and local building and safety codes.

## **PROTECTION OF PROPERTY**

The successful bidder shall at all times guard against damage or loss to the property of the Authority or of other vendors or contractors and shall be held responsible for replacing or repairing any such loss or damage. The Authority may withhold payment or make such deductions as deemed necessary to insure reimbursement or replacement for loss or damage to property through negligence of the successful bidder or his agents.

**INSURANCE REQUIRED**

The Bidder shall not commence work on any Authority Property until all insurance required as stated herein has been obtained and such insurance has been approved by the Authority. All insurance policies shall be issued by companies authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Florida. The Bidder shall furnish certificates of insurance to the Authority's Risk Management Section prior to the commencement of services. The certificates shall clearly indicate that the Bidder has obtained insurance of the type, amount, and classification as required for strict compliance with insurance requirements as stated herein, and that no change or cancellation of the insurance shall be effective without sixty (60) days prior written notice to the Authority. Non-compliance with the foregoing requirements shall not relieve the vendor of their liability and obligations under this contract.

The Bidder shall maintain comprehensive general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

The Bidder shall maintain comprehensive automobile liability insurance in the following amounts:

Bodily Injury and/or	\$ 1,000,000 each occurrence
Property Damage	\$ 1,000,000 aggregate
	or
Combined Single Limit	\$ 1,000,000 each occurrence/aggregate

These limits are to protect the Bidder and the Authority from claims for damage, which may arise from general operations or from the ownership, use, or maintenance of owned and non-owned automobiles, including rented automobiles whether such operations be by the vendor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by the vendor.

The Bidder shall maintain Workers Compensation insurance as per statutory requirements and Employers Liability limits no less than \$500,000 per occurrence.

**ALL** insurance shall specifically include the Authority as an "Additional Insured".

**PURCHASING AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES**

All Bidders submitting a response to this Quotation agree that such response also constitutes a quote to all political subdivisions under the same conditions, for the same prices and the same effective period as this quote, should the Bidder feel it is in their best interest to do so.

This agreement in no way restricts or interferes with the right of any political subdivision to rebid any or all items.

**CANCELLATION, WITHOUT CAUSE**

The Authority reserves the right to cancel this contract without cause via thirty (30) day written notice.

## **EQUITABLE ADJUSTMENT**

The Authority may, in its sole discretion, make an equitable adjustment in the Contract terms and/or pricing if pricing or availability of supply is affected by extreme and unforeseen volatility in the marketplace, that is, by circumstances that satisfy all the following criteria: (1) the volatility is due to causes wholly beyond the successful bidder's control, (2) the volatility affects the marketplace or industry, not just the particular successful bidder's source of supply, (3) the effect on pricing or availability of supply is substantial, and (4) the volatility so affects the successful bidder that continued performance of the Contract would result in a substantial loss. Any adjustment would require irrefutable evidence and written approval by the Director of Purchasing Services.

## **NO GUARANTEE OF AMOUNT OF WORK**

The bidder(s) should fully understand that the Authority does not, hereunder, contract to do any specific amount of work during the contract period. The Authority reserves the right to modify or terminate cleaning schedules at their discretion.

## **CHARACTER OR WORKMEN AND EQUIPMENT**

All equipment and workmen provided by the contractor for the work hereunder shall be the best available for the kind of work being performed. Any person employed by the contractor, whom the Authority may deem temporarily or permanently incompetent or unfit to perform the work, shall underwritten instruction of the Authority be removed from the job, and such person shall not again be employed on Authority projects. Failure by the contractor to provide adequate equipment may result in annulment of this contract as herein provided.

## **LAWS TO BE OBSERVED**

In the prosecution of this contract, the contractor shall exercise care to see that all Federal, State, County and Municipal laws, ordinances or regulations are observed, both by himself and his/her direct or indirect employees. He shall take reasonable care at all times to insure that proper protection of personnel involved is provided.

## **PREFERENCE APPLICATIONS**

A bidder who meets the qualifications for Local Preference and whose bid is within 5% of the low bidder who does not meet those qualifications, may be granted an opportunity to offer a best and final bid along with the low bidder and any other bidder(s) whose bid amount is equal to or less than the highest local bidder within 5% of the low bid. Contract will be awarded to the lowest best and final bid; in case of a tie for the lowest best and final bid the contract will be awarded to the lowest best and final bid offered by the local bidder. Ties between local bidders will be determined by a coin toss.

## **LOCAL PREFERENCE QUALIFICATION**

In order to qualify to receive points for location, the firm must have had its headquarters or branch office located within Palm Beach County for a minimum of one (1) year. The firm must have been incorporated or legally begun business, being fully licensed, at least one (1) year prior to the issuance of the solicitation. A valid Business Tax Receipt issued by the Palm Beach County Tax Collector is required and will be used to verify that the proposer had a permanent place of business one year prior to the issuance of the solicitation. Please note that in order to receive a local preference, the name and address on the Business Tax Receipt must be the same name and address that is included in the submittal to the Authority, and that the attached Business Tax Receipt must accompany the bid at the time of bid submission. Copies of licensure, leases of office space (or proof of ownership of office site) may be required by Authority staff as proof of compliance. The firm's office must be of a permanent nature not temporary or transient (i.e., mobile homes shall be without wheels and permanently affixed to the land). The firm's office shall be fully staffed with personnel including at least one of those assigned to the Authority's projects, office furniture, office equipment, and, if applicable, professional equipment/computers as required by the type of work to be performed. A site visit by Authority staff may be required to confirm local presence. The firm will be required to maintain said office, or other Authority approved offices, for the entire term of the contract. Failure to submit this information will cause the firm not to be qualified under this Section to receive a local preference. The Authority may require a firm to provide additional information for clarification purposes at any time prior to the award of the contract.

## **MINORITY/WOMAN/SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (M/W/SBE)**

Minority/Woman/Small Business Enterprise indicates a business entity which is owned and operated by a minority or woman. ## **OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL**

Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General, Ordinance (OIG) No. 2009-049 which is authorized and empowered to review past, present and proposed county contracts, transactions, accounts and records. The Solid Waste Authority (Authority) has entered into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for Inspector General Services. This agreement provides for the Inspector General to provide services to the Authority in accordance with the authority, functions and powers set out in the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General Ordinance. All parties doing business with the Authority and receiving Authority funds shall fully cooperate with the Inspector General including providing access to records relating to this Agreement. The Inspector General has the power to subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, require the production of records, and audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of the Contractor, its officers, agents, employees, and lobbyists in order to ensure compliance with contract specifications and detect corruption and fraud. Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interference or impeding any investigation shall be in violation of Ordinance 2009-049, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.

## **CONE OF SILENCE**

Bidders are advised that a Cone of Silence that prohibits any communication, except for written correspondence, regarding a particular request for proposal, request for qualification, bid, or any other competitive solicitation between:

Bidders or any person representing the Bidders and any member of the Solid Waste Authority Governing Board, their staff, any AUTHORITY employee authorized to act on behalf of the Authority to award the contract under this bid, or any member of the selection committee authorized to evaluate the proposals/bids/response.

The Cone of Silence shall be in effect as of the deadline to submit bids even if bid is withdrawn or is otherwise eliminated from consideration consistent with the procedures as outlined in this Bid. The Cone of Silence shall remain in effect until the Governing Board, or Authority staff, if authorized to act on behalf of the Board, awards or approves the contract, rejects all bids or otherwise takes action which ends the solicitation process.

The provisions of this article shall not apply to oral communications at any public proceeding, including pre-bid conference, oral presentations before selection committees, and contract negotiations during any public meetings, presentations made to the Board and protest hearings. Further, the Cone of Silence shall not apply to contract negotiations between AUTHORITY employees and the intended awardees, any dispute resolution process following the filing of a protest between the person filing the protest and any AUTHORITY employee, or any written correspondence at any time with any AUTHORITY employee, Board member or Advisory board member, or selection committee member, unless specifically prohibited by the applicable competitive solicitation process.

The Governing Board by means of action taken at any properly noticed Governing Board meeting may invoke the cone of silence earlier than the time specified in this section for any procurement.

## TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for the purpose of Pumping, Cleaning & Disposal of Solids and Liquids from the Oil Water Separator located at 6255 North Jog Road, West Palm Beach FL, in conjunction with the Authority's needs on an as needed basis. (No guarantee of amount of work).

This oil water separator has four areas that will need pumping and one is a confined space.

### Description of Work:

The work shall include, but not necessarily limited to the following:

1. Tank to be cleaned is located in the Inventory Department with restricted access for a truck. Suction hoses, minimum of twenty to thirty feet, will be used to access this tank. The tank size is forty eight (48) inches deep, forty inches (40) wide, and fifty one (51) inches long. The tank is in a concrete vault which is seven (7) foot wide, deep, and long. The vault has four access lids which weigh approximately 200 lbs each and must be manually moved to allow access to the vault area. This vault is confined space.
2. The outside pits are in a bay that has easy access. The pit sizes are as follows: Forty four inches deep (44), eighteen inches wide (18), and 10 foot (10) long. Two are eighteen (18") deep, fourteen (14") wide, and fifty eight (58') long
3. Vendor must have pressure cleaner to clean oil water separator and pits.
4. All solids and liquids will be taken to be disposed of in accordance with all environmental regulations.
5. Vendor must have ladder for easy access to pit. This is a confined space and all regulations regarding entry must be followed.
6. Vendor must state how much advance notice is required for job.
7. Vendor must arrive on job site at 9:00 am.
8. Vendor must give a firm quote for all pumping, cleaning, disposal, and all materials required to complete the job. This price is to include all travel, fuel surcharges, degreasers, equipment, and personnel required to complete job. No overtime or additional charges will be allowed.
9. Vendor must provide an invoice for the complete job within 14 calendar days.

It is anticipated that this job will be done four (4) times per year.
