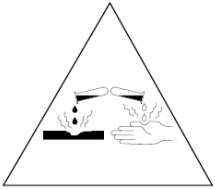




Don't Let Hazardous Waste be a Hazard to You!

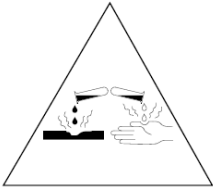
