



SPECIAL WASTE DELIVERY PROCEDURES

All disposal of Class A and B Special Wastes must be approved in advance by the Solid Waste Authority. Disposal shall be coordinated by Hazardous Waste Services with the appropriate disposal facility. Contact Hazardous Waste Services at 687-1100.

DELIVERY:

1. Delivery must be scheduled in advance unless otherwise noted and method of payment must be arranged at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance. Scheduled deliveries are accepted from 8 AM-11 AM and 1 PM-4 PM Monday through Friday.
2. A copy of the authorization letter, and if applicable, a copy of the billing letter shall accompany each load delivered.
3. Unless otherwise specified, all Special Waste deliveries must undergo inspection and obtain final approval at the Hazardous Waste Services office at 6161 N. Jog Road (1/2 mile north of 45th St., 2 1/2 miles south of Bee Line Hwy.).
4. An Authorization to Dispose will be issued by Hazardous Waste Services and the hauler will then be directed to the appropriate disposal facility. The vehicle driver shall present all paperwork to the Weighmaster at the facility scalehouse.
5. Special waste shall be placed in the appropriate disposal area under the direction of the landfill or facility site supervisor. Unloading must be performed by the hauler. The Authority does not provide assistance.

PAYMENT:

6. The disposal rate is indicated on the Authorization letter. Disposal rates are determined by the adopted Solid Waste Authority budget in effect and is subject to change with the adoption of a new budget. Payment shall be made at the scalehouse when delivered.
7. Payment may be made by:
 - Cash
 - In-state company check ONLY after approval from the finance department. A valid Florida Drivers License is also required.
 - Billing to an existing account. A letter, on company letterhead and signed by an authorized agent stating the account number to bill, may be required.

IMPORTANT:

8. Liquid or hazardous wastes, or wastes not fitting the description of the approved waste will be rejected.
