



ADDENDUM NO. 1
**DISASTER DEBRIS MANAGEMENT
AND SUPPORT SERVICES**
RFP NO. 17-205/SLB **FEBRUARY 22, 2017**

This Addendum to the specifications and contract documents is issued to provide additional information and clarification to the original RFP. In case of a conflict, this Addendum shall govern.

PROPOSERS shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by inserting this Addendum Number and Date issued in Proposal Form 1 – Transmittal Letter located within the original RFP documents. Failure to do so subjects PROPOSER to a determination of non-responsiveness.

Coding: Words in ~~strike-through~~ type are deletions from existing text and words in underlined type are additions to existing text.

A. Revisions/Clarifications to the RFP are as follows:

Part VI – Attachments – Sample Agreement, page 2, Article 4 – Insurance shall be revised to read as follows:

1. **General Liability** Insurance with bodily injury limits of not less than ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$2,000,000 for each occurrence, and with property damage limits of not less than ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$2,000,000 for each occurrence.
4. **Professional Liability** Insurance with limits of not less than ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$1,000,000 annual aggregate.

B. Responses to questions received on or prior to February 17, 2017 are as follows:

Q-1. We are a local certified SBE and MBE and are in receipt of the RFP# 17-205 Debris Management Support Services” RFP. It is noted an emphasis in the RFP for SBE utilization. It is also noted that no pre-proposal meetings is currently scheduled. Often, SBEs and Primes rely significantly benefit in meeting and interacting on possible teaming opportunities from pre-proposal meeting attendance. Would the SWA consider hosting a pre-proposal meeting for this RFP? This could be a very brief mandatory of non-mandatory pre-proposal mtg. Pre-proposal mtg serve also the very important function to allowed for interested firms to meet and possibly team which also serves to enhance SWA’s emphasis on SBE utilization.

A-1. See response to Question No. 3 below.

Q-2. The RFP Insurance limits requested for General Liability (GL) is \$5M and Professional Liability (PL) is \$5M. For SBE, small business, this represents exorbitant high limits that are usually carried by “construction firms” and may be requested by primes for SBEs to also carry. The Reasonable higher range limits carried by non-construction firms often are General Liability (GL) \$2M aggregate and Professional Liability (PL) \$1M. Would the SWA consider allowing SBE subs to carry GL \$2M aggregate and PL \$1M?

A-2. See Revisions in Part A of this Addendum No. 1.

Q-3. If a pre-proposal mtg is not possible can the SWA provide contacts for all firms that download the RFP to help primes identify possible SBE subs and to assist SBE subs in possibly reaching out to primes. This is similar to if an entity uses ONVIA to announce RFPs where interested entities that download RFP has their contacts visibly available for viewing and two way outreach communications.

A-3. No pre-proposal meeting will be scheduled. The Authority will provide the list of all vendors that were notified of the availability of the RFP, and a copy of the list of companies/individuals who registered on the Authority’s website to download a copy of the RFP.
